- 2. Plan to attend a two- or four-year college or technical school.
- 3. Plan to study environmental science, biology, chemistry or environmental engineering.
- 4. Complete an application.
- 5. Write a short essay about their career interests.

- Include a letter of recommendation from a teacher or community service leader.
- Include a high school transcript.
 Applicant's cumulative Quality
 Point Average at the end of the first semester of the senior year must be 3.0 or greater.
